

Note and Open Question regarding carved initials E. G. : Was E. Gentry a possible builder of the Wallin barn, based on some carved initials, carved with what appears to have been a chisel, a tool that would have been used in the construction. Emerson Gentry, son of John Gentry who owned an offsetting tract to the East, was born in 1916, after the estimated date of construction. Elias Gentry was a fairly common name, three in the 1850 census on the same page.
